Requirements

Six community service hours per week at the Fred LeRoy Health and Wellness Center

Periodic meetings with the professor to discuss progress in the field placement and the research paper.

A weekly two page journal reflection covering service experience integrated with previously learned anthropological and sociological knowledge as to compare this knowledge with the community service experience. Upload to the BSCW. The professor will comment on each reflection

A paper proposal which contains a paper title, an outline of the paper as far as possible at this point, and a minimum of 10 scholarly sources annotated with how the student will utilize each source. Proposal is due Monday, February 26, 2008. Upload to the BSCW

A paper draft indicating progress on paper to date. Draft is due Thursday, March 10, 2008. Upload to the BSCW

A final 10-25 paper that integrates research on poverty and Native American Health with the semester's experiences at the Fred LeRoy Health Center. Paper is due Monday, April 28, 2008. Upload to the BSCW
